



Stacia A. Kulpa

December 16, 1917 - July 3, 2007

Mrs. Stacia Ann (Wegrzyn) Kulpa, 89, of 13 Cross St., Adams, died Tuesday evening at Sweet Brook Care Center, Williamstown.

She was born in Adams on December 16, 1917, a daughter of the late John and Victoria (Wlodyka) Wegrzyn. She attended Adams schools.
