Mr. Stanley Bednarz, 73, of Adams, died on Sunday, May 13, 2018 at Berkshire Medical Center, North Adams.

He was born in Adams on May 27, 1944, a son of the late Stanley and Blanche (Lipinski) Bednarz. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams Memorial High School in 1962.

Mr. Bednarz was a Veteran of the Vietnam War, having served with the United States Navy until receiving his Honorable Discharge as Ensign 3rd Class on July 25, 1966.

Mr. Bednarz worked for General Electric Co., Pittsfield, as a machinist for both the Naval Ordnance and Power Transformer Divisions until his retirement.
