August 2, 1912 - December 15, 2006

Mr. Stanley Frank Janik, 94, of 34 Crotteau St. Adams, died early Friday morning at Williamstown Commons.

He was born in Adams on August 2, 1912, a son of the late Joachim and Amalia (Brach) Janik, and attended Adams schools.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy in the American, Asiatic-Pacific, European and Middle Eastern Theaters, until his Honorable Discharge in 1946.

Mr. Janik worked at Sprague Electric Co. in North Adams for 37 years, until retiring in 1977. Earlier, he had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.

He is survived by his wife of 66 years, the former Isabel Bernat, whom he married on May 22, 1940;
