January 25, 1935 - April 12, 2018

Mr. Stanley John Kestyn, 83, of Adams, died Thursday, April 12, 2018, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Montague, MA on January 25, 1935, a son of the late Stanley C. and Antoinette V. (Tranowski) Kestyn. He graduated from Turners Falls High School, then earned his Bachelor's Degree in Business from Bryant College in Providence, Rhode Island. He had lived in Adams for the past 48 years.

Mr. Kestyn worked as a sales representative for the Berkshire Gas Co. for 34 years. After retiring from Berkshire Gas, he worked for F.W. Webb Co. for several years, until finally retiring.

He was a charter member of the Knights of Columbus of Turners Falls, and was Past President and Secretary of the Adams Lions Club. He had also served as a member of the Massachusetts National Guard for 8 years.

He enjoyed travelling, fishing and cooking.

He is survived by his wife of 60 years, the former Elizabeth A. LaRoche, whom he married on February 8, 1958;
