March 13, 1920 - October 12, 2007

Stanley J. Lepak, 87, of 18 Victory St. Adams, died Friday morning, October 12, 2007, at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Northampton, MA. He was born in Adams on March 13, 1920, a son of the late Jan and Tekla (Golembiowski) Lepak, and attended Adams schools.

He was a Veteran of the Korean Conflict, serving with the 3750th Medical Group of the US Air Force, until his Honorable Discharge in 1952.

Mr. Lepak worked for several years at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams.

He is survived by 1 Sister - Helen Wandrei of Adams, and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.
