



Stanley Polchlopek

April 6, 1924 - September 4, 2006

Mr. Stanley Walter Polchlopek, 82, of 1100 Mohawk Trail, died Monday September 4, 2006, at Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston, MA. He was born in Dalton on April 6, 1924, son of the late Albert and Rose (Pierowicz) Polchlopek. He attended schools in Pittsfield, and graduated from Pittsfield High School with the class of 1944.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the United States Navy.

Mr. Polchlopek had worked for several various construction companies throughout Berkshire County on several different projects, including the Bear Swamp Project in Monroe, MA, and was in the maintenance department of the Charles H. McCann Vocational High School until his retirement in 1986. After retirement he worked part time for General Electric Co., and the former Brenner Associates, both in Pittsfield.

He was a former member of the First United Methodist Church, North Adams.

He is survived by his wife, the former Irene B. Graney whom he married February 24, 1973.
