Mr. Stanley Peter Wilk, 89, of Cheshire, died on Tuesday, September 12, 2017 at Craneville Place in Dalton.

He was born in Adams on June 6, 1928, son of the late Frank and Sophie (Bezak) Wilk. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School with the class of 1946.

Mr. Wilk worked for many years in the Power Transformer Division of General Electric Co., Pittsfield until his retirement.

He was a communicant of St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Cheshire. He was a former member of the Polish National Alliance, the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society and the Cheshire Rod & Gun Club. He had coached for Cheshire Little League and was an avid New York Yankee and Giants fan.
