



## Mrs. Stella (Fournier) Beaudin

June 21, 1948 - October 5, 2015

Mrs. Stella M. (Fournier) Beaudin, 67, of 1 Harding Ave., Adams, died on Monday, October 5, 2015 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

She was born in North Adams on June 21, 1948, a daughter of Marguerite (Couture) Fournier and the late Adrien Fournier. She attended schools in North Adams and graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School in North Adams with the class of 1966.
