Mrs. Stella Marie (Lemoine) Kondel, 95, of Adams, died on Saturday, February 22, 2020 at Mt. Carmel Care Center in Lenox. She was born in Adams on February 5, 1925, a daughter of the late Peter and Antoinette (Leonard) Lemoine. She attended schools in Adams.
