Mrs. Stella M. (Zoltek) Zatorski, 87, of 20 Manners Ave., Adams, died on Tuesday December 18, 2007, at the North Adams Regional Hospital.

She was born in Adams on September 26, 1920, a daughter of the late Stanislaus and Catherine (Boruta) Zoltek. She attended schools in Adams.

Mrs. Zatorski was a Veteran of World War II, having served with the Women's Army Corps in the Asiatic-Pacific Theatre from 1943 until her honorable discharge in 1945. She was very proud of her military service.
