



Stephen F. Albareda

September 22, 1958 - April 9, 2013

Mr. Stephen F. "Yumpa" Albareda, 54, of 11 Columbia Terrace, Adams, died on Tuesday, April 9, 2013 in Canaan, NY.

He was born in Adams on September 22, 1958, son of the late Frederick and Florence (Bourdon) Albareda. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School.

Mr. Albareda was a Veteran, having served with the United States Army from 1976 until receiving his Honorable Discharge in 1979.

At the time of his death, Mr. Albareda was working as a facilitator, for Berkshire Farm Center in Canaan, NY

He was a communicant of the Parish of Blessed John Paul, Adams. He was an avid sports enthusiast, and especially enjoyed the New York Yankees and all the sporting events of the Hoosac Valley Hurricanes. He was the voice of Hurricane Football for many years and has been the announcer and a coach for Adams Youth Football. He had also been a coach for the Adams Little League and Church League.

He is survived by his wife, the former Lisa A. Gelheiser, whom he married on June 21, 1985;
