



## Mr. Stephen W. Nowicki

February 10, 1922 - March 6, 2016

Mr. Stephen W. Nowicki, 94, of 6 Mill St., Adams, died on Sunday, March 6, 2016 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on February 10, 1922, son of the late Joseph and Sophie (Bieniek) Nowicki. He attended schools in Adams and graduated from the former Adams High School.

Mr. Nowicki last worked for the Town of Adams Cemetery Department until retiring. Earlier he had been the owner and operator of the former Berkshire Dairy and the former Burke's Inn. He had also worked for the former Arnold Print Works in Adams.

Mr. Nowicki was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Army Air Corps as a pilot and received his Honorable Discharge on October 27, 1945.

He was a communicant of the Parish of St. John Paul II, Adams, and St. Mary of the Assumption Church, Cheshire. He was a member of the Adams Post 160 American Legion, the Adams Lodge of Elks and the Mountain Club. He was also a member of the former Thunderbolt Racers. He was most proud of his 4th place finish in 1942.

His wife, the former Mary F. Skubel, whom he married on March 19, 1945, died on August 16, 2014.

He is survived by;

3 Sons – Thomas Nowicki and his wife Claire of Longmeadow, Gregory Nowicki and his wife Deborah of Adams and Paul Nowicki of Palmer;

His Daughter-in-Law Joyce Nowicki of Adams and his Son-in-Law – Bruce Sherman of Florida;

10 Grandchildren, 7 Great Grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

He was predeceased by his daughter, Christine Sherman and by his son, John "Jack" Nowicki.

The funeral will be on Friday, March 11 at 10:00AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St., Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 11:00AM in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, celebrated by Rev. Steven Montesanti, Pastor.
