On August 10th 2022, Tammy Perreault died tragically on Surfside Beach, South Carolina. Tammy was born in Adams, MA on May 14th, 1959 to Robert and Jane (Kolis) Gilman. She graduated from Hoosac Valley High School in 1977, and from Berkshire Community College. She spent her younger years in Massachusetts.
