Terry Joseph Romaniak, Esquire, 55, of Holyoke, died unexpectedly on Christmas evening, December 25, 2009, at Holyoke Hospital.

He was born in Adams, MA on October 29, 1954, a son of Florence (Zabek) Romaniak and the late Anthony J. Romaniak. He attended Adams schools, and graduated from Hoosac Valley High School in 1972. He graduated from the former North Adams State College in 1976, and then graduated from Western New England College School of Law in 1985.

An attorney for over 20 years, he practiced for several firms in the area of real estate law, and was currently working as the Branch Counsel for Old Republic National Title Insurance Corp. in Springfield.

He was a member of the Massachusetts Bar Association; the Real Estate Bar Association for Massachusetts; and the Ludlow Country Club.

He loved the outdoors, and was an avid golfer and skier. He was a dedicated single father.
