



Thaddeus J. Golec

July 22, 1917 - October 19, 2009

Mr. Thaddeus Joseph Golec, 92, of 65 Summer St. Adams, died Monday afternoon, October 19th, at North Adams Regional Hospital.

He was born in Adams on July 22, 1917, a son of the late Albert and Josephine (Nowak) Golec, and attended Adams schools.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Army in the 9206th Military Police Detachment, until his honorable discharge in 1946.

Mr. Golec first worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. in Adams until the mill ceased operations. He then worked at Pfizer, Inc. in Adams for 22 years, until retiring in 1979.

He was a communicant of the Parish of Pope John Paul the Great, Adams, and had been a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He was a former member of the St. Stanislaus Kostka Society.

He enjoyed golfing and bowling, and was an avid fan of the Boston Red Sox and New England Patriots.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, the former Daisy A. Kalisz, whom he married on June 9, 1947; and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

He was predeceased by a sister, Stacia Kopala, and by two brothers, Frederick and Ernest Golec.

The funeral will be held on Thursday, October 22nd, at 9:00 AM from the PACIOREK FUNERAL HOME, 13 Hoosac St. Adams, followed by a Liturgy of Christian Burial at 10:00 AM in the Parish Church of Pope John Paul the

Great, Adams.

Burial will follow in St. Stanislaus Kostka Cemetery, Adams.
