



## Theodore W. Zatorski

July 1, 1919 - November 13, 2007

Mr. Theodore Walter "Ted" Zatorski, 88, of 20 Manners Ave. Adams, died Tuesday afternoon, November 13, 2007, at North Adams Regional Hospital. He was born in Adams on July 1, 1919, a son of the late John and Katherine (Swiek) Zatorski. He attended Adams schools.

Mr. Zatorski was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Army Air Corps in the European Theater.

He worked as a machinist at General Electric Co. in Pittsfield for 40 years, until retiring in 1982.
