Mr. Thomas F. Chalifoux, 74, of Berkshire Square, Adams, passed away on Wednesday, August 20, 2025, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Pittsfield on October 20, 1950, a son of the late Jean and Catherine (Coyne) Chalifoux. He attended schools in North Adams and graduated from the former St. Joseph's High School. He went on to study at the Bridgeton Academy Prep School in Bridgeton, Maine and the Lester Junior College, Lester, MA.

Tom built a long career driving and delivering for UPS in Pittsfield until retiring in 2013 after 35 years.

IN his younger years he had a deep passion for skiing. Later in life he spent most of the summer and fall at his camp in Vermont where he loved being on his boat and taking pictures of the eagles.

He is survived by his wife, the former Carolyn M. LaBonte, whom he married on September 10, 1977.

He was predeceased by his brother, Michael Chalifoux and by his two sisters, Mary Ann and Cathy Chalifoux.
