



Thomas V. Houghtaling

Mr. Thomas V. Houghtaling, 61, of 799 East Road, Stamford, VT, went home to the Lord on Friday, May 8, 2015 at his home surrounded by his family.

He was born in North Adams on July 4, 1953, a son of the late Fred Latown and Helen Houghtaling. He attended schools in North Adams.

Mr. Houghtaling last worked as a safety specialist for the Cianbro Corporation, Bloomfield, CT.

He was a member of the Stamford Community Church, where he had served as chairman of the Board of Trustees and was a member of its sound committee. He was the chairman of the Stamford Family Day Committee, a member of the Stamford Select Board and a past member of the Stamford Volunteer Fire Department. He was also a member of the National Rifle Association. Tom was a "Jack of all Trades", he enjoyed working on his home, doing Auto Body work, and was a sound reinforcement engineer. He loved hunting, fishing, four wheeling, sugaring, bowling, playing the drums and traveling in his motor home. He was a dedicated New England Patriots and Boston Bruins fan, win or lose he never gave up on his team. Tom was a longtime advocate for the Leukemia-Lymphoma Society, having traveled to many locations as a guest speaker and in 2013 was honored in Nashua New Hampshire as an Honored Hero.

He is survived by his wife, the former Deborah Jones, whom he married on June 22, 1974;
