Mrs. Verna Leona (Haggstrom) Eastwood, 91, of 35 Victory Terrace, Adams, died late Wednesday evening, February 1, 2012, at her home.

She was born in Salem, MA on December 18, 1920, a daughter of the late Henry and Anna (Lindgrin) Haggstrom, and attended Salem schools. She had lived in Adams since 1941.

Mrs. Eastwood last worked as a manager at Thrifty Bundle Launderette in Adams for several years. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co., Brightwater Paper Co., L.L. Brown Paper Co., Joanne Bakery and Signet Corp., all in Adams.
