Mrs. Victoria Josephine (Kopec) Zoltek, 87, of 12 Hoosac St., Adams, died on Saturday evening, July 24, 2010, at the North Adams Regional Hospital. She was born in Adams on January 19, 1923, a daughter of the late Tytus and Anastasia (Wlodyka) Kopec. She attended schools in Adams and graduated from St. Stanislaus Kostka School and the former Adams High School with the Class of 1940.

Mrs. Zoltek worked for the former Sprague Electric Co., North Adams for 36 years, until retiring in 1986. Earlier she had worked for the former Northern Berkshire Electric Co.
