



## Vincent Beaudin

Vincent Emile "Vinnie" Beaudin, 58, of 1 Harding Avenue, Adams, died Sunday morning at the North Adams Regional Hospital, shortly after being admitted.

He was born in Adams on September 16, 1946, a son of the late Victor M. and Alma M. (Tremblay) Beaudin. He attended the former Notre Dame School in Adams, and graduated from the former St. Josephs High School in North Adams.
