Mr. Wallace Smith Griswold, 94, of 29 Burt St. Adams, died early Tuesday morning at North Adams Regional Hospital following a short illness.

He was born in New Lebanon, New York on August 21, 1910, a son of the late George and Hattie (Van Hamlin) Griswold, and came to Adams as a child, attending Adams schools.

Mr. Griswold last worked at Pfizer, Inc. in Adams until retiring in 1975. Earlier, he had worked as a truck driver at the former H.W. Clark Biscuit Co. in North Adams, and as a youth had worked for several area farms.

He was a member of the United Methodist Church of Cheshire, and the National Rifle Association.
