



## Walter W. Avery

September 29, 1927 - February 5, 2013

Mr. Walter W. Avery, 85, of 7 Mountain View Drive, Adams, died Tuesday afternoon, February 5, 2013, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Belmont, MA on September 29, 1927, son of the late Abraham and Rachel (Wilkinson) Avery, and attended Belmont schools. He had lived in Adams since 1950.

He was a Veteran of World War II, serving with the US Army until his Honorable Discharge in 1950.

Mr. Avery last worked as an Electrical Supervisor for Pfizer, Inc. in Adams, until retiring in 1990 after 30 years of service.

He was a member of the First Congregational Church of Adams, where he served as a Deacon. He was a former member of the Town of Adams Finance Committee, and was also a member of the Adams Lions Club.

He enjoyed woodworking, photography, working on his computer, and could fix just about anything.

He is survived by his wife of 63 years, the former Anita "Orleta" A. Kirk, whom he married on May 21, 1949;
