Mr. Walter B. Baran, 87, of 37 Alger St., Adams, died on Saturday, April 2, 2016 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on April 26, 1928, a son of the late Walter and Stephanie (Milos) Baran. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Baran was a Veteran of World War II having served with the United States Navy aboard the U.S.S. Roosevelt.

Mr. Baran last worked as a machinist for the Yankee Atomic Electric Company in Rowe.
