



## Walter Gliwski

Mr. Walter Stanislaus Gliwski, 83, of 26 John St., Adams, died on Saturday, April 3, 2010, at his home.

He was born in Adams on December 6, 1926, a son of the late John and Katherine (Czech) Gliwski. He attended schools in Adams.

Mr. Gliwski was a Veteran of World War II, having served overseas with the United States Navy on the USS Webster and the USS Bataan until receiving his Honorable Discharge on June 20, 1946.

Mr. Gliwski worked for General Electric Co., Pittsfield for 17 years, retiring in 1988. Earlier he had worked for the former Sprague Electric Co., North Adams, for 25 years.

He was a communicant of the former St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams, where he also served as a choir member and usher for several years. He was a member of St. Michael's Society, the Polish National Alliance, St. Stanislaus Kostka Society and Adams Post 160 American Legion.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, the former Claire R. Denno, whom he married on August 2, 1947;
