



Walter Wojtusiak

April 23, 1921 - September 26, 2007

Mr. Walter Charles Wojtusiak, 86, of 6 Sparrow Street, Adams, died Wednesday afternoon, September 26, 2007 at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on April 23, 1921, a son of the late Matthew and Veronica (Strzepek) Wojtusiak, and attended Adams schools.

Mr. Wojtusiak was a carpenter by trade, and worked for many years for the Carpenter's and Tradesman's Union in Pittsfield. Earlier, he had also worked as a farmer, and for the Town of Adams Department of Public Works.

He was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. He enjoyed fishing, mechanical work, and especially enjoyed his grandchildren.

His wife, the former Helen B. Strzepek, whom he married on May 8, 1948 in St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, died on July 4, 1989.

He is survived by 2 Daughters - Joyce Grabicki and her husband, Richard, of Adams, and Deborah Kogut and her husband, Michael, of Savoy;
