



Wanda S. Armstrong

October 19, 1918 - April 30, 2006

Mrs. Wanda Stella (Czarnik) Scholz Armstrong, 87, of 3 Second St. Adams, died early Sunday morning at her home.

She was born in Adams on October 23, 1918, a daughter of the late Frank and Katherine (Ciolkosz) Czarnik, and attended Adams schools, including the former Adams High School.

Mrs. Armstrong last worked as a bookkeeper at White Eagle Printing Co. in Adams. Earlier, she had worked at the former Berkshire Fine Spinning Co. and the former L.L. Brown Paper Co., both in Adams, and at the former Adams Super Market in Adams.

She was a communicant of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church, Adams. She was a member of several bowling leagues, and had played basketball as a youth for the St. Stanislaus Athletic Club.

She was an avid Boston Red Sox fan.

Her first husband, Richard Scholz, whom she married in 1943, died in 1959.

Her second husband, C. Howard Armstrong, whom she married in 1964, died in 1988.

She is survived by 1 sister - Daisy Dyka of Adams;

1 brother - Matthew Czarnik of Adams; and several nieces, nephews, grandnieces & grandnephews.

She was predeceased by 2 sisters, Mary Kleiner and Gladys Zarvis.
