



Mr. William F. Bellman III

April 23, 1927 - May 23, 2014

Mr. William Francis Bellman III, 87, of Wray, Colorado, formerly of Notch Rd. Adams, died Friday, May 23, 2014, at Wray District Community Hospital in Wray.

He was born in Williamstown, MA on April 23, 1927, son of the late William F. Bellman II and Anna (Mulqueen) Bellman. He attended Williamstown schools, and graduated from the former Williamstown High School. He lived in North Adams for several years, and had lived in Adams for over 50 years, before moving to Colorado in 2013.

He was a veteran of World War II, serving with the US Navy , until his Honorable Discharge in 1953.

Mr. Bellman was a third generation carpenter, and had worked for several contractors in the Williamstown area, including John Hammann and the late Davy Dean and Robert Jones, until retiring in 1999.

He attended the First Congregational Church of Adams, and was a member of American Legion, and the United Brotherhood of Carpenters and Joiners of America Local 108. He was also a member of the daily "coffee club" at McDonald's in Adams.

He was passionate about fly fishing, and he loved animals, sports, a great meal and a good cup of coffee.

His wife, the former Marjorie J. Hathaway, whom he married on November 22, 1952, died on April 10, 2012.

He is survived by a son, David F. Bellman and his wife, Darla, of Wray, CO,

with whom he resided;
