



## Mr William E. Burdick

July 21, 1931 - July 25, 2022

William E. 'Bill' Burdick, 91, of Adams, died on Monday, July 25, 2022, at Albany Medical Center, after a short illness.

He was born in North Adams on July 21, 1931, the son of the late Lawrence and Helen (Reynolds) Burdick. He attended schools in North Adams, graduated from Drury High School and later, completed courses in mathematics and electrical engineering at North Adams State College.
