



## William G. Shephard

November 10, 1944 - January 11, 2006

William George Shephard, Sr., 61, of 8 Glen St. Adams, died Wednesday, January 11, 2006, at Berkshire Medical Center in Pittsfield.

He was born in Adams on November 10, 1944, a son of the late Emery and Phyllis (Rougeau) Shephard, and attended schools in Adams and North Adams, and graduated from Drury High School.
